- Please meet the ministry leader(s) and discuss how you can best be involved in this ministry. (Bear in mind that this will not be the only thing you'll be doing over the coming months.) Also, with their help, choose an appropriate Ministry Mentor to help you in this ministry.
- Please obtain approval once more from your Pastoral Coach regarding your kind and level of involvement, and regarding your Ministry Mentor.
- Now, please formalize your relationship with your Ministry Mentor:
 - Nature of relationship. The special nature of this relationship is that you are to serve your
 Ministry Mentor in a way that he or she thinks appropriate for the furtherance of the
 ministry. In the Big Challenge Project you will build your own vision; in this project you will
 serve the vision of another.
 - Mutual expectations.
 - Frequency of communication and contact. On the following page are some sample questions to use during your meeting times.
 - Relationship between Ministry Mentor and Pastoral Coach.
- Please formally make a commitment regarding your involvement to the ministry leader(s).
- Please send a summary statement regarding all the above to the ConneXions Director for his final approval.
- Please complete the above process before the end of Module 2.
- This ongoing ministry involvement and mentoring relationship will be monitored over time by your Pastoral Coach and is not "set in stone" in case any changes are necessary.
