Exercises

1. (*Individual*) Meditate on Genesis 3 asking the Holy Spirit for insight. Answer the following and give any additional insights.
 - a. What part of God’s Word has the tempter been questioning in your life?
 - b. How much did God give Adam and Eve in the Garden?
 - c. Was there anything bad in the Garden of Eden?
 - d. What was at work in the woman when she looked at the forbidden fruit?
 - e. Compare/contrast the curse directed toward the serpent and those against the man and woman.

2. (*Individual*) Study the following verses. Write a summary statement describing what each passage is saying.
 - a. Romans 5:12-19
 - b. Genesis 6:5
 - c. Psalm 14
 - d. Romans 3:10-23

3. (*Team*) In teams of two or three, choose one of the following lists of Scriptures. Write a statement summarizing what these verses are saying. Come up with a creative way to presents this fact/facts to the cohort (use art, skit, song, etc.).
 - a. Romans 3:9-10, 22, 23; Psalm 14; Isaiah 53:6
 - b. Romans 5:12, 16 and 19
 - c. Romans 3:19; Gal. 3:10; Eph 2:3; John 3:36
 - d. I John 3:8-10; John 8:44; I John 5:19
 - e. Romans 7; John 8:31-36; Eph 2:3
 - f. Eph. 4:18; I Cor. 2:14; Jeremiah 17:9-10; Gen.6:5; Titus 1:15; II Cor. 7:1; Rom. 7:15, 18.

4. (*Individual*) Write a brief paper on “The Fall of Man”. In it answer the following:
 - a. What is the fall of man?
 - b. What was the result?
 - c. Why did it occur?
